



Snowflake Fundraiser!

What It's For: To help me go on our 4th grade Raleigh trip

How Long We are Fundraising: December 3rd-February 1st

How It Works: Buy a snowflake to hang in the hallway at London Elementary. You can make your snowflakes in honor of or in memory of someone special. All money goes directly to me for my trip!

Snowflake Prices:

White Snowflake: \$1

Silver Snowflake: \$5

Gold Snowflake: \$10

Directions For When Someone Purchases:

1. Explain what they are purchasing and why (use blurb below if needed)
2. Ask which size snowflake that they wish to purchase
3. Collect the money and place in the envelope
4. Record who purchased, what size they purchased, the quantity of snowflakes purchased, how much money was collected, and who it is "in honor of" or "in memory of" on the chart.
5. Bring your collected money and information to school on a "Turn In Day" and your teacher will record the name on the Snowflake and it will be placed in the main hall of London Elementary for everyone to see.

Turn In Days

On the dates listed above, you may bring in your money and information that you have collected between that period of time. Your teacher will record the payments that you have made and the amount that you have fundraised that goes towards your Raleigh trip.



Blurb for Students
